COURSE DESCRIPTION

This program is an update of current information on MR Imaging in the assessment of musculoskeletal disorders. Essential anatomy and physiology are emphasized that explain imaging findings in disorders of the shoulder, elbow, wrist, hand, hip, knee and ankle. MR imaging findings in the assessment of common problems in peripheral joints are compared to those derived from other imaging methods.
